and the reft to fatisfy their Curiofitys. Goods are feldom landed the firf Day; it being fufficient to fecure the Ship, fend the Company's Packet a Shore, and get Refrefhments for the Men, which they are prefently fupply'd with from Country Boats and Cattamarans, who make a good Peny at the firtt coming of Orombarros; as they call thofe who have not been there before.

Goods that turn to the beft Account from Europe, are Lead, Wine, Beer in Casks and Bottles, Ale, Sider, Cheefe, Cloth-Hats, fine Ribands, Goldand Silver Lace, and Thred Woolfted-Stockings, Flint-ware, LookingGlaffes, Light-colour'd Whigs, Stuffs for Coats, with trimming, Cafes of Spirits, Cherry Brandy, Cafe Knives, Tinn-ware, Tobacco Pipes, and all forts of Haberdafhery. Bullion is either coin'd into Rupees, or bought up for the China Market, where Pillar Dollars are moft efteem'd, and therefore bear the higheft Price here. The Madra/s Dollar-weight is $17 d w t$. $4 \mathrm{gr}^{-\frac{2}{1} \frac{2}{3} \frac{6}{3}}$. A confiderable Quantity is feldom bought or fold, but the Shroffs, who are of the Cbitty Caft, and in general Brokers to this Bufinefs, examine and weigh it impartially betwixt both Parties; having a fmall Allowance for their Care.
